Prophets and Ladies,

Did you know that Norm Peters compiled a history of the first 100 vears of Mohassan Grotto? It covers the start of the first Grotto west of the Mississippi on November 25, 1907, when a meeting was held to obligate seven local men as Prophets. At this same meeting, the name "Mohassan" was adopted. Mohassan was an aged guardian of the Rightful Prince of Ormus, and he raised the Prince from infancy on the banks of the River Amoo in Persia. These new Prophets then petitioned the Supreme Council to operate under dispensation.

On February 26, 1908, a class of 65 candidates was obligated, and Mohassan received its charter on July 8, 1908. We received the 24th charter in the Realm. However, two earlier Grottoes had relinquished their charters, so we became the 22nd active Grotto. Louis Gates served as Monarch while under dispensation, and he was succeeded by Louis Block.

The first home of Mohassan Grotto was in the Masonic Temple at the north-east corner of Third and Main Streets. At the Supreme Council Convention on October 20, 1903, the Black Fez was adopted as the official headgear of the Realm. The Purple Fez is reserved for Grand Line Officers of the Supreme Council.

There are four different colors of tassels: Red tassels for Grotto members and officers, except for the Monarch and Past Monarchs who wear purple tassels; silver tassels for elected and appointed Grand Line Officers, except for the Grand Monarch and Past Grand Monarchs who wear gold tassels.

The first issue of the Mohassan Grotto Booster was January 1928. And now you know!
